ABOUT THE PARK

Richmond Park, at almost 1,000 hectares (2,500 acres), is the largest Royal Park in London and is home to around 650 free roaming deer. The Park is designated as a National Nature Reserve (NNR), a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) and a Special Area of Conservation (SAC).
